Being organised.

There are pages for: reading, spelling, maths and times tables. See page 107 onwards. Having a water bottle (with a sports top) in class also makes a big difference to your child- please remind him/her to take it home for a wash out on Fridays.



PE **PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday**-it is really helpful if kits are in school all week so that we can take advantage of any extra opportunities that arise.

The weather is changing now so please make sure your child has a coat for playtimes and any days we are out on visits.



The power of 10. Helping your child to learn.

Reading-please do your best to read with your child for 10 minutes every day.



“It is a proven fact that children of all ages and levels progress even more when they benefit from additional support at home.” “Pupils who read for enjoyment every day or almost every day achieve a significantly higher score than those who read once a week or not at all.”

Spellings and times tables- a few minutes every day makes a huge difference. When a child knows their tables maths becomes so much easier for them –percentages, fractions, ratio all rely on multiplication and division knowledge. The Y6 curriculum requires fast thinking and efficient methods and accurate work in all subjects.
