Year 6 SATS Results

We are extremely pleased with the Year 6 SATS results which were published last week. The children have all achieved well and should be so proud of themselves. Early indications are that the school will be above national averages in every area and significantly so in certain aspects. It is particularly pleasing to see the positive impact upon the reading progress and attainment; as you know this has been a focus this year. We will not know the full school progress measures until early in the autumn term but these are also looking positive. Well done children and thank you to the whole staff team for their continued hard work.

Local Authority Review

We had two advisors from North Yorkshire Local Authority review the work of the school before the half term break. I am pleased to inform you the team agreed with all of the School Self Evaluation Judgements which leaders and governors had assessed as good in every area. Aspects such as leadership and management, teaching and learning, behaviour and safety and pupil outcomes were reviewed as part of the day. One of the many positive comments in the report refers to the ethos of the school and excellent behaviour of the children:

'The school has a tangible ethos that is positive and caring, putting the welfare and well-being of each pupil at the heart of all that it does. This is clearly seen in the friendly, happy and confident manner of the pupils at Barlby Bridge Community Primary School. The school's strong emphasis on modern British values helps pupils to understand and respect others who may have different views or lifestyles to their own. The curriculum also engages pupils and helps to enhance their spiritual, moral, social and cultural development.'
