What activities do children do?

Children will follow the same routine to allow children to stay safe and explore the area in a sensible manner. We have an introduction, reminder of forest school rules, main activity and closing session.

Each session we have a different focus which may include:

- Using leaves and natural materials for art
- Looking at trees, leaves and flowers
- Exploring natural objects
- Story telling
- Den making
- Mini Beast hunting
- Making a fire

With all activities there are many opportunities to incorporate the areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage.
