Maths Homework may be given via the My Maths website. Can I also remind you of the continued importance of times table practice.

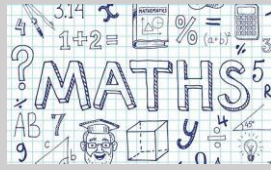

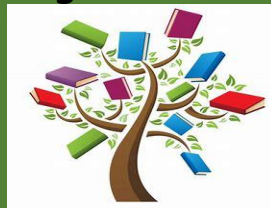

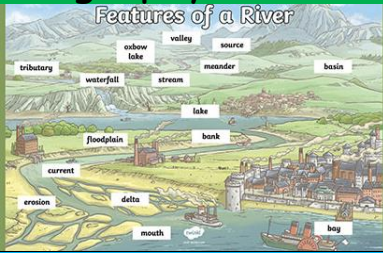
